
## Adding an Exclusion to Antivirus for Laredo

This example will be using **AVAST!** <sup>®</sup> antivirus software.

1. Open Avast user interface in System Tray by right-clicking on the Avast icon and selecting "**Open Avast user interface**" at the top of the selection menu:
