Release Notes

Classic Search Vertical Layout – [VIEW VIDEO OF THIS NEW LAYOUT](#)

The **biggest change** you will see is the new layout for the **Classic Search** screen; the screen has changed from a quadrant to a vertical layout. With the increase of search features and capabilities, the vertical layout allows for a more seamless integration of these changes. *Additionally, you will notice that users are no longer restricted to one “Additional Criteria” category.*

In the new layout, the left side of the screen now has an area to summarize what criteria have been entered (see 1A below) so that searchers will not need to scroll to check their entries.

The right side of the screen includes a navigation menu (see 2A below), which searchers can use to “jump” to a desired section rather than scrolling. [VIEW VIDEO OF THE SEARCH CRITERIA](#)

Document List/Range Search (Counties with the latest search update only. See next page for details.):

Users can type in two different doc numbers for a range, the same doc number to look up a specific doc, or non-sequential documents separated by commas. [VIEW VIDEO OF THIS FEATURE](#)

Book / Page (Libre / Page)

Book / Page (libre / page) has been moved out of the “Additional Criteria” options and into the “Document” section (see 3A below). The visibility of Book / Page is still configurable by the county.

Individual Columns for Legals in Results

This feature is only available in counties with the latest search update

If you are unsure if the county in which you're searching is upgraded or not, please contact Support or the Partner Relationship Manager. Otherwise, the most tell-tale sign is the inclusion of Access Codes on the search screen.

Another big change is that upgraded counties will now see **Legals** and **Notes** in their own columns in the "Results" screen (see 1C below). Below is a list of columns that are now included in the grid of indexed data:

- Subdivision
- Parcel
- Tract
- Address
- Municipality
- Survey Map (CSM)
- Notes

You will see a (+) indicator next to an entry if there is more than one entry of that type (see 2C below). You can hover over this indicator to see, *at most*, the next 10 entries of that type.
